

Favorite Upset In Handball Tournament

Brown Defeats Snow; Quarter-final Round Scheduled for Today

Another favorite dropped by the wayside yesterday in the all-university handball tournament when Al Brown upset Jack Snow 16-21, 21-19, 21-9 to enter the quarter-final round.

Snow, runner-up in last year's tourney and seeded second this year, played a steady cautious game in the first game, out-maneuvering his larger opponent. In the second game Snow came within two points of winning the match but Brown rallied and won 21-19. Al Brown had things his own way in the third and deciding game, which he easily won 21-9. He will meet Bob Pofcher in the semi-final round tonight at 7:30 p.m.

POFCHER MEETS BROWN

Pofcher, the ex-Bruin handball star who was the only Uclan to win his match last year when SC met his old alma mater, advanced to the quarter-finals last Friday when he scored an easy victory over Wes Stone. The unexpected upset by Brown over Snow was the surprise of the tournament yesterday and the match between Pofcher and Brown should be doubly interesting because in the earlier rounds the ex-Bruin upset Romeo Rodriguez, a handball team member who was seeded fifth.

The quarter-final round matches will get underway tonight at 7:30 and 8:30 p.m. in the men's gym. Of the men left in the play, only three are seeded: They are Al Perel No. 3, Fred Nicholas No. 4, and Dick Steckel, No. 1.

FEATURE MATCH

The round tonight will feature a battle between Bill Voorhees and Perel. Voorhees hit his stride last week, after getting off to a slow start, when he defeated Stan Koskoff.

Dick Steckel, defending champ, will be matched against Ron Lubin, tennis star who turned handballer, and Fred Nicholas will be playing Al Mahaffay, husky varsity handball player. Brown and Pofcher will complete the round when they tangle at 8:30 p.m.

The victors will enter the semi-final round after the matches tonight and the playoffs will be completed next week.
