

# Fred Nicholas, Rodriguez Gain Handball Finals

Fred Nicholas and Romeo Rodriguez blasted their way into the finals of the all-U handball tournament last night in the men's gym with a 21-13, 9-21, 21-14 victory over Marty Ziff and Bob Pofcher. The match lasted for two hours.
