

# *S. C. Student Journalists Edit Daily Facts Today*

While regular staff members took a day's vacation, today's edition of the Redlands Facts was written and edited by eight students from the University of Southern California school of journalism. The students, going through the routine of publishing a daily newspaper, are getting practical experience in the profession which they will follow after their graduation.
